
Participants' Feedback & Evaluation of the "Social Entrepreneurship and Innovation Ecosystem Workshop"



1. Were you satisfied with the logistical aspects: application process, communication and practical details, travel and accommodation, etc.?




2. Did the Workshop overall match with your expectations? Were there topics that were not discussed that you felt should have been discussed?

 - I think everyone wants different things and everyone is at a different level of their enterprise, so you can't make everyone happy anyway.


6. What was good about the Workshop? Was there something that you particularly enjoyed or found interesting/useful?

 - Friendly organizers/instructors. It made me comfortable to share and learn.


7. What was not so good about the Workshop and could be improved? Was there something you really did not enjoy, or that was problematic?

 - I think we had some issues with the conference room venue. It was street-facing, which resulted in a lot of noise during the presentations. Also, I think that we could have structured the agenda to allow for a longer mid-day break or evening activities. In general, I think the agenda had great content, but maybe could have been re-shuffled a bit to give more clear sequence and connectivity between presentations.
